- Limit the impact and avoid any harm to the environment through our business activities and our products. Among other things, we are committed to:
 - Knowing our carbon impact and setting targets for reducing it
 - Controlling our water consumption and the quality of our water and air discharges
 - Implementing sustainable management of our resources, energy, chemicals, and reducing the amount of non-recoverable waste.
